As a B-to-B trade show specialised in artificial intelligence, it gathered 105 exhibitors from 6 countries(Singapore, Spain, Czech, Korea, Taiwan and Japan); 8,449 visitors; 5,943 conference attendees and 108 press members. Although this was the very first autumn edition, AI EXPO TOKYO has firmly established itself as an ideal platform for quality business in Japan, a promising market for the future growth.

The Best Gateway for International Exhibitors to expand business in Japan

This year, AI EXPO TOKYO Show Management offered Remote Exhibiting Plan for the international exhibitors unable to physically attend the show due to COVID-19 travel restrictions. The plan includes a bilingual staff and a tablet device to help exhibitors' online meetings. AIMMO, an exhibitor from Korea, had approx. 100 online appointments and is expecting the total of 50-100 million yen worth orders, and commented "The bilingual staff on site was really helpful and compensated for our absence on site".

Seoil E&M (Korea) also generated 80 or so appointments and anticipates 200 million yen orders in total. They believe that AI EXPO is the important occasion to enter the Japanese market and meet new buyers.









Concurrent Shows

Exhibition Under COVID-19

AI EXPO TOKYO was held taking safety measures following the guidelines of the government, municipalities and the exhibition industry association.

- ➤ Use of personal protection equipment including face shields and masks, thermal screening for staff / exhibitors / visitors, and reduced seating for seminars to ensure social distancing.
- Exhibitors also employed measured to preserve physical distancing by barriers and decreased densities at their booth.
